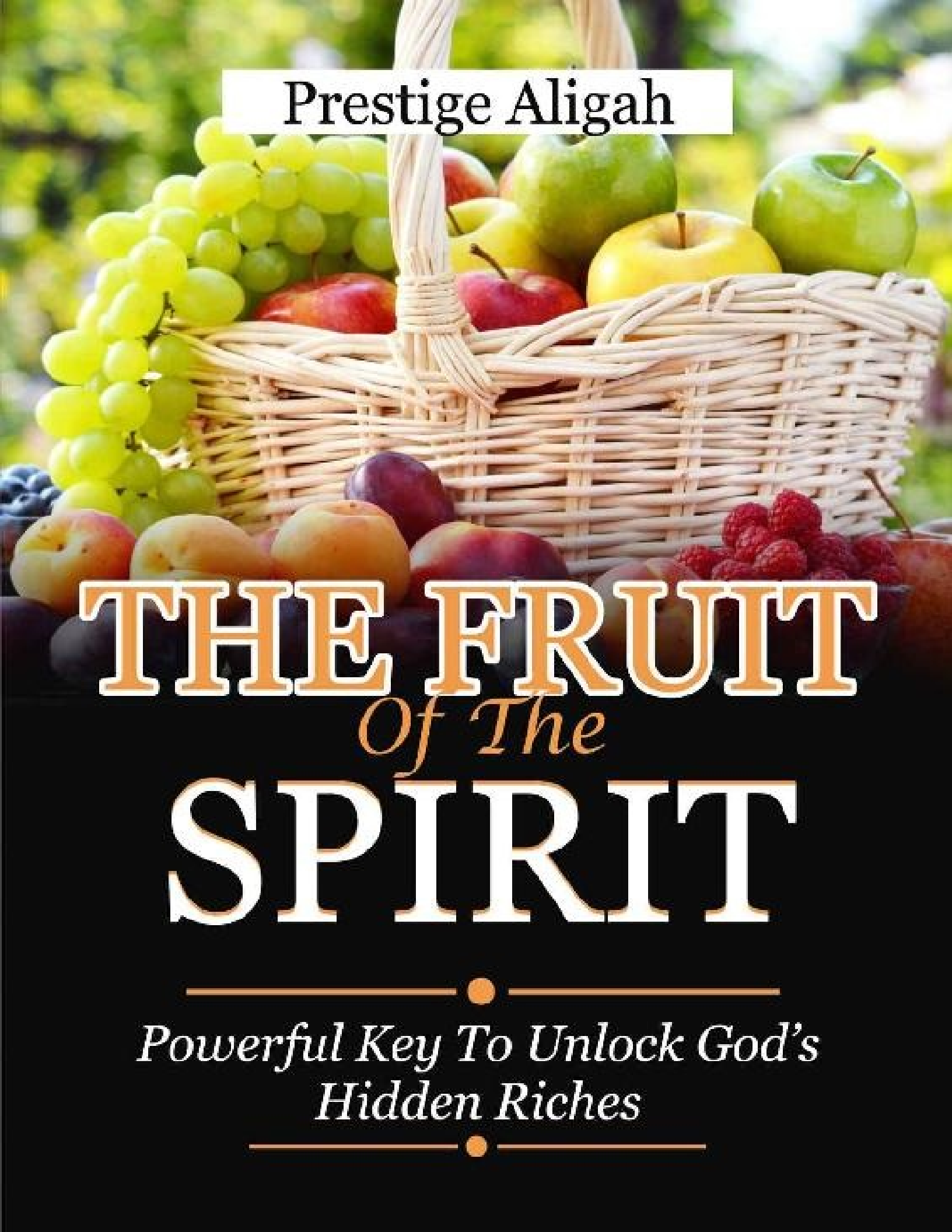

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Introduction

Hosea 4:6

My people perish for lack of knowledge; Information is the power between success and failure. You need the right information to succeed in your life. This is another chance for you to access the secret riches of God that will support your experience. The reality is that we have great churches, great preachers, but sadly we have no great people. This implies that people don't adapt to change. People will hear the Word of God every Sunday, every month, every year, but the Word does not affect their lives. Often the preachers tend to wonder why people don't change.

God has made the fruit of the Spirit available in us, so we can connect to His supernatural power that will unlock His blessings for us.

I'm not writing as a simplistic writer or a preacher, but I'm writing as a shepherd who loves and cares for the flock, and I love seeing people develop both physically and spiritually.

A good shepherd wants to see his people's lives improve for good, but sometimes they don't seem to achieve this result, and it's going to be a significant challenge for them.

They pray for people, they counsel them, they sow in their lives, they give them all sorts of support, and their lives stay the same.

Because of the divine grace of God, I want to introduce to you a powerful book

that has the key to unlock God's hidden riches, a book that contains the right information that will change your life for good.

The prayer in chapters seven and eight is a must-read; please don't skip it for any reason. Remain blessed.

Chapter: 1 Jesus Is The Sower

When Jesus was speaking with His disciples about why people are not consistent in fellowshiping with God, or why people are not growing both physically and spiritually. When people come to Church every Sunday to worship God, it is a sign that they love and hunger for God. However, not everyone who comes to God or claims to be a Christian wants to grow spiritually.

Since Jesus has fed the five thousand people with five loaves of bread and two fishes, the next day they were all looking for Jesus, and Jesus understood their motive, He told them that He knew they were not looking for him because of the Word of God, but because of the food.

This means many people in the Church today have their interior motive, so people are not growing spiritually.

Jesus took His text from the book of;

Luke 8: 4-15

The Parable Of The Sower

And Jesus was narrating a parable to them about a sower who goes to sow his seed every day, and each time he sows his seed, and some seed landed on various types of soil.

Wayside, rock soil, thorny soil, good soil. Based on the ground the seed landed on, it determined the result of the seed.

Whoever you hear every day is a sower in your life, and he has what it takes to change your life. Your pastor, preachers, your boss, politicians, business partners, and so on. What they do is to sow seed in your life by telling you words, especially those who speak the truth to you. People hear from different sower, the same seed, but unfortunately not the same result. Yes, people hear the Word, but not all that change.

In our Churches today, everybody doesn't become spiritually matured, so people don't change.

The reason is that people are not the same soil. It is the soil that determines the result of the seed you planted.

4 Various Types of soil and what they represent:

- Wayside soil
- Rocky soil
- Thorn soil
- Good soil

The sower represents Jesus; the seed is God's Word, while the soil means you or the people.

What happens to a seed when planted in the ground: the seed needs to die first, break into two parts; if the weather condition of that soil is right, then the seed will germinate or survive to bear many fruits. If the ground is the wrong type of soil, the seed will not do well.

But if the seed did not survive, the forth is not from the sower nor the seed but the soil.

Chapter: 2- The Reason Why People Doesn't Change Or Grow Spiritually.

In the book of Luke 8: 4 - 15, where Jesus took this parable and its illustration, He mentioned different kinds of soil and how the effect the seed. Jesus talked about the first type of soil.

THE WAYSIDE SOIL

The sower went out to sow his seed, the seed fell on wayside soil, and it was rolled down, and the fowls of the air devoured it. The seed that supposed to germinate, but because it was the wrong type of soil, something took or smashed it away. Now from his illustration in Verse 12, Jesus said, those by the wayside means people that heard the Word of God, the devil came and took the Word of God away from their heart. So that they will not believe and be saved. The same thing is happening in our Churches today; people go to Church every Sunday to hear the Word of God; along the line, something will happen that will take away God's blessings in their lives. It could be a quarrel with your wife on your way home or something that you cannot even explain. Or before the week runs out, they will fall into temptation before you know it; the Word that is supposed to bring change in their life is gone.

THE ROCK SOIL

In verse 6 of the same chapter, He also talked about the rocky type of soil. One good thing about seed, it's so powerful that it can germinate on rocky ground, but because it lacks moisture when the wind blows, it weather away. Water is so essential that it will supply the necessary ingredients that the seed will require to germinate in the soil. His illustration in verse 13: moisture means the presence of God. Those are the people that received the Word of God with joy, then Word of God has no root in them because they hardened their hearts. They believed for a while when temptation came, and it falls away. The reason is because of the lack of the presence of God in them. The Word of God is so powerful that it can crush anything that wants to take it away from you and make reasonable changes in your life, but due to the hardness of your heart, the indwelling Spirit of God will be absent; no good result will be achieved. The Word of God is living water that flows all over your Spirit, soul, and body. No wonder Jesus told the woman of Samaria, if you know who was asking you for water and the kind of water He shall give to you in returns, you would have asked him to go with the well because Jesus is the living water.

THE THORN SOIL

In verse 7: And some seeds fell among the thorns, and they sprang up with it and choked it to death.

From His illustration in verse: 14, they are those when they have heard the Word of God; they go out and choke with cares, riches, and pleasures of this life and bears no fruit to perfection. These categories of people have refused to surrender totally to God. Like I have said, the Word of God is living water, but they drink different kinds of water: night club, politics, friendship; they are tired with worldly affairs, so the Word of God cannot flow in them, and their life will remain the same.

GOOD SOIL

In verse: 8, some seed fell on good soil, sprang up, and bear fruit a hundredfold. After Jesus had said all these things, He cried out and said, he that had ears let him hear.

From His illustration in verse:15, the right soil represents those who have an honest and fair heart, which after they have heard the Word of God, they keep it, meditate on it and bring forth fruit with patience. People who have to noble heart. A noble nature is transparent, pure, and sincere. A heart without grudges, malice, or bitterness. These are the people that will grow spiritually, and the change will manifest in their life.

Beloved, I want to encourage you as a pastor to belong in this category of people to attract God's glory that will bring changes upon your life.

Chapter: 3 How to Sustain The Glory or The Power of God in Your Life.

What is the glory of God?

The glory of God is the manifestation of the power of God in the beauty of His lioness upon the life of a believer so that people may witness the goodness of God.

Isaiah 60: 1-3

Arise, shine for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD has risen upon you. 2. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth and gross darkness the people, but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and His glory shall be seen upon thee. 3. And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

One of the best ways to sustain the glory of God is by worshiping him always.

The presence of God in the life of a believer will determine your spiritual growth.

OTHER WAYS TO SEE THE GLORY OF GOD IN ACTION

- By trusting and abide in Him
- By showing love and kindness to people
- Always ask for His mercy each time you wrong Him.
- Prayer
- Be productive
- Always give thanks
- If you must grow spiritually with the power and presence of God always with you, learn to worship and appreciate him still.
- Raise your hands in the congregation and worship him, thank him for the good things he has done in your life and how much you love him. Some people quote the scripture, but they lack the power of God in them.
- Worshiping God is the moisture that you need to water your seed. If you are doing this always, then trust and cast your burden upon him.

I don't know how he will do it but be rest assured that God must surely intervene in your situation.

Sometimes, circumstances around you can weaken your Spirit in such a way that you cannot pray or know what to pray for. In a situation like that, start with

praise and worship; this will help to soften your heart. Remember all the miracles, blessings, healing, open doors, etc. and humble yourself before him. Also, meditate on the Word of God because the Word of God is God Himself.

John 1:1

In the beginning, was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Chapter: 4 Care, Riches, and Pleasures of This World.

God wants everybody to succeed socially. He wants us to find a supply (necessities) for our everyday lives. He also wants us to appreciate the riches (abundance) of his generosity. Moreover, the universe of God has enough resources to provide everything that we need. That being said, in the fallen world in which we live, many people do not encounter the full provision of Heaven. Others find that their needs are met, but only at considerable expense (emotional, economic, relational, economic, moral, or spiritual) to themselves and others. Then other individuals have attained considerable economic wealth, but this is done by hurting others or themselves. Whatever the financial condition we find ourselves in, questions and doubts about God's meaning and role in supply and wealth weigh heavily on almost every Christian's mind. These problems are at the center of the wealthy and the poor; employers, workers, job seekers; students, parents, pensioners; homeowners, renters, and homeless people. However, these three things (Care, Riches, and Pleasures of this World) are strong desires that can affect your spiritual growth. The Spirit of God is gentle; it doesn't like distractions. When you pay too much attention to cares, riches, and pleasures of this world, the Spirit of God will be far from you. Remember, a friend to the world is an enemy to God. Evil association corrupts a satisfactory manner. You want to belong; those things you pay much attention are things that

you are faithful to. For instance,

You want to care much about friends and relationships.

You value your work more than God.

You prefer to go jogging than to pray.

Every time you are always in one queue or the other.

Those things you pay more attention to are things you are faithful to. If you are chasing after these things, they will chock out the Word of God in you. Don't chase after riches but chase after God.

Matthew 6:33

But seek you first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you.

When you are so committed to this world's affairs, you will lack the presence of God, which is the main thing that will positively affect your life. But when you are committed to the things of God, riches will be chasing after you.

Walk with God and allow God to plant His seed in you. He wants people with a good heart, those who are ready to please Him by keeping His commandments.

When you keep God's Word, He will keep your job, marriage, health, and everything that concerns you. Check your life; God is always planting a seed in you, don't allow cares, riches, and pleasures of this world to take it away from you.

Chapter: 5 Powerful Key to Unlock God's hidden Riches.

God has made His Treasures and riches available for us through His Word; all you need is to queue into His Word and command these blessings into your life.

Please quietly read and meditate on these bible verses.

Isaiah 45:3-25

In verse 3 of the above scripture, God stated clearly that He would hand over the unbelievers' riches to you. Only those who have grown spiritually can access or hand these beautiful blessings from God.

Spiritual growth simply means growing mature in Spirit to overcome the flesh's works and connect to the Spiritual things like our Lord Jesus.

You are moving away from your formal status to grow maturely in Spirit to understand God's Word to become a true believer.

In Christendom, we have two types of Christians. The baby Christians and mature Christians. The babies Christians are also called milk Christians. These are those who eat or interpret soft words. While mature Christians are those that eat hard bones, they interpret hard or complicated words.

Spiritual growth is essential because it is one of God's desired principles for our prosperity. God wants us to grow in Spirit and not live in the flesh because the Spirit controls the physical. Growing to be like Jesus is God's desire. The

number of trials you overcome will determine the level of your spiritual growth.

Prosperity is a command from God and not a struggle. It your right to prosper after God has created everything, both the animals and all that we need to live on the surface of the earth. He commanded that man should have dominion over everything. If you have been struggling to make ends meet that is not the original plan of God for your life. You need a change by building your spiritual living so that you can access the promises of God upon your life.

Chapter: 6 Characteristics or Attributes of a Matured Believer.

Maturity in Christendom refers to those who have grown in Spirit or serving to be like Christ.

Spiritual growth is a personal decision; to some people, when they accepted Christ, they work toward growing in Spirit by been more committed to the things of God. While to others, after confessing Christ, they feel so reluctant to walk with God, and before you know it, they go back to their vomit,

God will never force you to serve Him or to grow in the Spirit, is you that will decide how you will develop yourself because no matter what the case may be, your decision will never change God. Your decision to grow in Spirit will grant you access to unlock the hidden riches of God. But before one begins to have access to God's secret riches, at least your character or personal conduct will be an excellent example to other believers around you.

Many have accepted Christ for one year, two years, five years, ten years, etc. Their spiritual life remains stagnant.

The Word of God is a portion of spiritual food; the riches and all the good things we need on this earth are hidden in the Word of God.

- He wants to become a leader
- He will be humble and obedient
- He bears good fruits
- The believer will experience positive changes in his life
- He preaches the gospel of truth

HUNGER TO SERVE GOD

This attitude of wanting to serve or fellowship with God always must be seen in a mature believer's life. When a believer is hungry and thirsty for God anyway, it shows that such a believer loves God because loving God with all your heart is one of God's greatest commandments.

Matthew 22:37-38

Jesus said unto him, Thou shall love the LORD thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 28. This is the first and great commandment.

ALWAYS STUDY AND MEDITATE ON THE WORD OF GOD.

2 Timothy 15

Study to show yourself approved unto God: the workman that needed no to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of the truth.

As a mature believer, you have overgrown certain teachings; you will always dig deep in the Word of God to gain more knowledge and also to know the truth.

You need solid food that will sustain you or keep you alive in Spirit.

HE IS EAGER TO BECOME A LEADER IN THE MINISTRY

Becoming a leader is one of the characteristics of a mature Christian; this will help to teach or impact to the beginners what you have learned or study. After studying and keeping it to yourself, it makes no meaning; your study will bear fruit if you sow it in others' lives. Look for a platform where you can share your knowledge with people.

HUMILITY AND OBEDIENT

A mature believer has a humble spirit, and he is ready to obey God's Word at all costs. He must practice what he teaches to people. Someone people can emulate and use it as an excellent example for others. When Abraham obeyed God, He counted it for him as righteousness. When we obey God's Word, it signifies that we love God.

John 14:15

If you love me, you keep my commandments.

HE BEARS GOOD FRUIT.

In the book of Genesis, God commanded man to be fruitful, multiply and replenish the earth; unfortunately, many believers are in the Church today unproductive. The reason is that they lack spiritual growth. A mature believer is expected to bear fruit that people will recommend as good fruit. People should be able to witness the fruit of the Spirit in you according to the book of

Galatian 5:22-23 which is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control

These are some evidence that you are a real child of God; let the people witness this evidence in you.

THE BELIEVER WILL EXPERIENCE POSITIVE CHANGE IN HIS LIFE.

Change is very compulsory for anything that has to do with growth. Someone can't work faithfully with God, and your life remains the same. There will be a positive change in your career, marriage, finance business, in everything that concerns you.

Chapter: 7 The Fruit of The Spirit.

The wellbeing that gives meaning to fruit is often common to everyone.

Not only is fruit nutritious, cholesterol-free, and fiber-blessed, but it strengthens our memory and helps us feel better while eating it.

Admittedly, some fruits have more advantages than others, and each of us has a favorite of our own.

However, it can usually be assumed that fruit helps preserve good health.

In biblical times, the fruit was incredibly valuable to individuals.

One of the great promises made by the Lord to the Israelites after their exile from Egypt was that there was ample fruit in the land to which he was leading them (Deut. 8:8; cf. Lev. 25:19).

As Nehemiah exclaimed in his praise of the blessings of God to his people, the land was fertile, with such "pleasant things" as vineyards, olive trees, and abundant fruit trees (Nehemiah 9:25).

It is no wonder, then, those words synonymous with fruit can be found hundreds of times in the Bible.

We will mention particular cases in the following analysis where the

The imagery of fruit has been used to communicate a special spiritual meaning in metaphorical phrases.

Having noted some general teachings concerning the high value of fruit, before

drawing some theological applications for believers, we will concentrate on those fruits that contain distinctive emphases in the Scriptures.

The Following Are The 9 Fruits Of The Spirit That Must Be Embodied By Any Good Believer.

1. Love

Love is interpreted from the Greek term

?? γάπ tra, (agape) in Galatians 5:22-23.

Greek has numerous love terms, including eros, which is sexual love and Philos, which is fraternal love.

'Agape' is the ultimate love

that God alone can offer.

According to Vine's Expository Dictionary, "In terms of agape as used.

by God, it reflects the deep and persistent 'love' and concern of a

perfect being towards completely unworthy things, creating

and cultivating a reverential 'love' in them towards the Giver, and a practical

'love' towards those who are participants of the same, and a

Desire to enable others to follow the Giver.

The outcome of receiving God's perfect agape

'love is love for God and others.

Jesus sent his followers encouragement:

As my Father loved me, so did I love you.

Abide in my devotion now.

If ye keep my commands, ye shall abide in my love, even as

I have held the commands of my Father and abide in his love.

"This is what I have told you, that my joy may

be in you, and that your joy may be full" (John 15:9-11).

2. Joy

It's a pleasure in this passage. Chara is also translated as joy or delight. It is also seen with fun in the Bible. It is the awareness of the favor and grace of God in one's life. Biblical joy is a pleasure that does not depend on our circumstances.

Paul urges us to do this:

"Consider it with pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face many kinds of trials, for you know that the testing of your faith creates perseverance"

(James 1:1-2).

3. Peace

The Biblical idea of peace, in the Greek Eirene, is inclusive of non-conflict life as well as wholeness and harmony with God and others. A life of leisure is both physically and mentally healthy and comfortable.

"The mind governed by the flesh is death; but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace" (Romans 8:6).

Peace is the product of allowing the Holy Spirit to function within our hearts and minds. When we have peace, we are afraid and worried about finances, our survival, our salvation, and our eternal life. The fruit of the Holy Spirit is seen in the peace that comes even though our conditions are far from calm. Jesus inspired his followers in John 16:33, "I have said these things to you, that you may have peace in me. You're going to have trouble in this world. But take your heart! I have conquered the entire universe.

4. Obedience

Obedience is not a term that is widely used by most of us. The Greek Word in Galatians 5:22-23 is also translated by other names such as patience, endurance, constancy, steadfastness, perseverance, longsuffering, and slowness in vengeance. The Holy Spirit empowers believers to stand up to difficult circumstances with persistence and resilience.

The Greek root of this Word refers to two words that are long and emotional. With the Holy Spirit, we can wait longer until we indulge in our passions—we become "long-tempered" rather than "short-tempered." Paul mentioned this Word when he defined Jesus' patience with him.

"For this very reason, moreover, I had been shown compassion, so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus could show His immense patience as an example to those who would believe in Him and receive eternal life" (1 Timothy 1:16).

Like Paul, we also have gained from the infinite restraint of Christ with us. The proof of the Holy Ghost in human lives has been seen in our capacity to stay the course, to be patient, to be steadfast, and to be lengthy-tempered. Ephesians 4:1-2 urges us "to be wholly gentle and considerate; to be careful, to be in love with others."

5. Kindness

The sense of moral goodness, dignity, utility, and benignity is expressed by kindness (chréstotés). In the King James Edition, this term is interpreted as "gentleness," which ties it to the sense of a gentleman or a gentlewoman, someone who acted appropriately, with moral honesty and kindness. Romans 2:4 tell us that it is the goodness of God that leads us to repentance, not to judge. That Holy Ghost helps us to have moral dignity with compassion and not to be caught in the judgment of self-righteousness.

6. Goodness,

Goodness (those) means uprightness of heart and existence, integrity, and kindness. Integrity can be seen in our acts. The phrase applies not only to be healthy but also to doing positive things.

That Modern English version of 2 Thessalonians 1:11 underlines this sense, "They pray for the strength of God to help you do all the positive things that you plan to do, and your faith makes you willing to do." they were firm in their souls because they do pleasant aspects.

7. Faithfulness

(Pistis) is the evidence of the power of the Holy Spirit in our life. faithfulness is a quality of personality that blends trust and confidence, based on our belief in God and His eternal devotion.

In the Christian Bible, religion is the religious faith and the assurance which Jesus is the Messiah from which we have everlasting redemption.

"With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his call, And it is through his power he will bring to fulfillment your every strive for righteousness, and your every act of faith. "2 Thessalonians 1:11.

8. Gentleness

In the King James edition, "meekness" was translated as "meekness"; however, since it appeared low, modern versions of the Bible use gentleness to mean gentleness of disposition.

Baker's Evangelical Bible Dictionary states, "Meekness does not describe the poor, but rather the strong, who are put in a position of weakness where they persevere without giving up. The use of the Greek Word when applied to animals makes this obvious since it means 'tame.'

In other words, these animals have not lost their power, but have learned to regulate destructive instincts that prohibit them from living in harmony with others.

Jesus describes himself as gentle in Matthew 11:29, "Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls."

9. Self-monitoring or control

Self-control is the capacity to control one's body, and one's seductive appetites and impulses – both physically and mentally – by the influence of the Holy Spirit. Self-control concerns both faithfulness and staying sober and, besides, restraint in eating and drinking. Self-control is the opposite of the works of the flesh that fulfill sensual impulses.

Like Galatians 5:16 states, "And I say, walk in the Spirit, and you will not be pleased with the desires of the flesh.

For the flesh wants that which is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit wants that this is opposite to the flesh. They're in disagreement with each other, so you don't have to do anything you want.

Chapter: 8 14 Powerful Prayer Points To Unlock God's Riches Upon Your Life.
